- 6- They are required to submit all the requirement documents.
- 7- They are needed to sit entrance exam and score pass.

- To develop study timetable and evaluate it.

INTRODUCTION

In order to ensure that students effectively complete secondary cycle and enhance selection of post secondary education course that mest the interest and ability of students, in which will be resulted better employment and coreer development. Thus, it is necessary to equip students with necessary counseling that enables them to

is obligation to all students in secondary schools in Puntland either to select Arts stream or Science stream, which is foundation of appropriate selection of post secondary education course

It was noted, that many students select a stream that it does not meet their interest and career due to lack of proper counseling during selection of secondary stream. At the attending post secondary education, they recognize that their stream in secondary does not relevant to their study course in university. For instance, a student select Arts stream and then attending a course that requires math and science, so this will end up drop out and obtaining limited skills due to inadequate of foundations. In order to overcome above mentioned problem, it is vital to establish counseling service in secondary schools. This will foster the capacity of students to make proper selection both secondary stream and post secondary education course.

SELECTION OF POST SECONDARY COURSE

When the selection of secondary stream was done properly, it very easy to selection a university course that related to your secondary stream. Before selection, you have to understand university environment;

In generally university courses were designed to support students to develop self-leaning and independence. Students are encouraged to develop creativity and self expression at the beginning of the university course. So, university is required to help students.

 This is a right time to selection not only secondary steam, but also post secondary school course. A number of factors may determine this selection process. However, when you selecting your stream in secondary school, you have to consider the following:

o Interest: Interest is very important when you selecting a course of your choice. So, answer this question, what is your interest in terms of science and arts stream?

o Ability: Interest alone may not quide to make proper choice of secondary stream, so ability is necessary. Answer this question: are you good in arts subjects or science subjects?

o University Course. You have to know that you choice in secondary steam will have impact an your university course. Thus, you have to carefully think how secondary steam links to university course. For instance, you may choice science steam and you want to study in the university public administration. In such case, your secondary steam may not link to university course. However, someone who perused arts steam in secondary and studied a public administration cause in the university.
